What happens when visual and performing artists collaborate? A unique fund-raising partnership, Moving Parts. Inspired by CityDance Ensemble and published by Pyramid Atlantic Contemporary Art Center, this collector's set of ten miniature artist books is housed in a custom-made clamshell box, offered in a limited edition.

Ten artists were given full access to CityDance rehearsals and concerts over the course of the 2008-2009 performance season. The results are nothing less than stunning, reflecting ten unique responses to themes that moved each artist: global warming, relationships, pattern, and personal reflections on dance to name a few.

Included with the boxed artist book collection is a companion booklet of essays and artist statements, plus a 30-minute documentary about the project on DVD with artist interviews and dance performances.

The Moving Parts artists are: Irene Chan, Paul Gordon Emerson, Leah Frankel, Kerry McAleer-Keeler, Patricia Lee, Moira McCauley, Kelly O'Brien, Elizabeth Parnum, Beverly Ryan, and Gretchen Schermerhorn, with a commissioned essay by Susan King, accomplished book artist and pioneer in the field.

Don't miss this rare opportunity to collect from ten different artists, whose work is housed in private and institutional collections such as the National Museum of Women in the Arts, Tate Modern, British Library, Victoria & Albert Museum, Walker Art Center, New York Public Library, Yale University, Janet Turner Print Collection, UC Irvine Library Special Collection, and exhibited worldwide.

Only forty boxed sets are being offered to collectors. All proceeds benefit CityDance and Pyramid Atlantic.
